Mu Phi Epsilon was founded at the Metropolitan College of Music in Cincinnati, Ohio on November 13, 1903 by Professor Winthrop S. Sterling, Dean of the College, and Elizabeth Mathias, a faculty member. Professor Sterling wanted an organization for women to parallel his organization for men, Phi Mu Alpha. There were 14 members in the first chapter in 1903. Today there are 130 collegiate chapters including two in the Philippines, 89 alumni chapters and more than 38,000 members.

In order to join Mu Phi you must be a second quarter freshman majoring or minoring in music and have a music GPA of 3.0 and an overall GPA of 2.5 or special permission. Here at Eastern the Epsilon Iota Chapter of Mu Phi sponsors both faculty and student concerts throughout the year. We incorporate our Music Therapy program with schools in the area. At EWSC we usher for all of the concerts and recitals and handle receptions at the request of the performers. In our concert this evening, we want to show you the lighter side of our group.
